



USS Ronald Reagan (CVN 76) Ship Opening 2015



USS Ronald Reagan will be open to the public at
Yokosuka Naval Base.

- Date: Oct. 12 (Mon) , 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. (**Last entry : 1 p.m.**)
- Entry : Mikasa Park Gate

15min. walk from Keikyu Yokosuka Chuo Station/20 min. walk
from Shioiri Station, 25 min. walk from JR Yokosuka Station

- Qualifications to participate : **Please refer to page 2 and after.**
- Cancelled in case of a storm

Note :

- Route: Walk from the Mikasa Park Gate to USS Ronald Reagan, back to the Mikasa Park Gate.
- The tour might be cancelled without notice, based upon the situation around the world, and weather condition.

Qualifications & Notes to Participate in the ship tour

- This event is only to visit USS Ronald Reagan. There will be no deviation from the queue route.
- **Age Limit: 6 or older (No infants or toddlers will be allowed.) Older than 75 must be able to walk safely to the ship and up and down the stairs without assistance.**
- **Pregnant women are not allowed for safety reason.**
- **Guests must be able to walk and climb steep stairs without any walking aid such as a walker and wheelchairs.**
- **Please bring one of the Base-designated IDs below, which is checked at the gate.**
- **Base-designated IDs for Non-Japanese guests are:**
 1. Passport
 2. Special Permanent Resident Certificate (ZAIKYU CARD)

*Driver's license and Basic Resident Registration Card with picture are **not acceptable for non-Japanese guests.**

- **IDs for Japanese guests:**

1. Passport
2. Basic Resident Registration Card with picture
3. Driver's License

- **ID For Jr. and high school students:**

1. Student ID





<Clothing>

- **Please wear low-heeled walking shoes and pants as possible.**
- High-heels, roller shoes, and Kimonos will not be allowed.
- No offensive clothing will be allowed to enter the base.

<Belongings>

- **Everyone is required to go through Security Check at the gate**
- No large-sized bags (* Smaller than 30cm x 30cm may be acceptable) are allowed. No wheeled carry-ons, large backpacks, large bags or coolers will be allowed.
- No drones, tripods or stepladders are allowed.
- No Pets, Hazardous materials , Cans or Bottles are allowed.
- No weapons are allowed to enter the base:
 - For example: No swords, knives, or guns or toy weapons.
- No Bicycles or Skateboards are allowed.
- No Alcohol is allowed.
- People under the Influence of alcohol will not be allowed to get onboard the ship.
- Activities such as sales of goods, business promotions or advertisement, taking surveys, and distributing flyers are not allowed.
